Flea Treatment Instructions

- Make sure your pet has been treated for fleas. Please use Frontline or an equivalent to treat your pet. Make sure that the active chemical in the product you use to treat your pet has the active chemical 'fipronil'.
- Make sure all personal items (ie: toys, clothes, shoes, and etc.) are picked up off of the floor. It is not necessary to remove furniture. You may leave all furniture where it is at in your home.
- Please be prepared to leave for 1-2 hours when the technician arrives to do your treatment. This will include the need to make arrangements for your pets to be out of the home during and 1-2 hours after treatment.
- Please thoroughly wash and clean all areas frequented by your pet, such as pet beds and blankets.
- Vacuum your carpets every 2-3 for the first two weeks. If you have a bagless vacuum cleaner, it is a good idea to get a cheap flea collar and put it in the canister when vacuuming. Dump the canister immediately after vacuuming and save the flea collar for future use.
- Flea activity may still be present for up to two weeks after treatment. If you still notice activity after that, please call to schedule another treatment
